The purpose of this All County Information Notice (ACIN) is to provide counties with the revised California Child and Family Services Review (C-CFSR) statewide five-year schedule for 2018 – 2022. The statewide C-CFSR five-year schedule in this ACIN supersedes ACIN [I-37-17E](#).

## **BACKGROUND**

Assembly Bill 636, Chapter 678, Statutes of 2001, and Welfare and Institutions Code (W&IC) Section 10601.2 required the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) to establish the C-CFSR process. The C-CFSR process ensures county accountability and improve outcomes for children through the implementation of the core outcomes of the federal CFSR.

The purpose of the C-CFSR is to significantly strengthen the accountability system used in California to monitor and assess the quality of services provided on behalf of youth in the foster care system. As such, the C-CFSR operates on a philosophy of continuous quality improvement, interagency partnerships, community involvement and public reporting of program outcomes. The C-CFSR is comprised of county child welfare system and probation placement reviews and maximizes compliance with federal regulations for the receipt of federal Title IV-E and Title IV-B funds. Principal components of the C-CFSR process include: 1) County Self-Assessment (CSA), 2) County System Improvement Plan (SIP), and 3) County System Improvement Plan Progress Reports (SIP Progress Reports).

The C-CFSR five-year schedule is based on a calendar year. The first page of the attached calendar is an overview of CSA due dates for all counties across the five-year cycle. The remaining pages of the calendar provide the continuing C-CFSR schedule identified in ACIN [I-37-17E](#). All reports are due on the dates identified in the statewide five-year schedule. If the due date falls on a weekend, state or county holiday, the report will be due on the following shared business day. Pursuant to W&IC Section 10601.2, the C-CFSR requires the use of indicators consistent with federal outcome measures. On October 11, 2016, the Administration for Children and Families (ACF) issued Technical Bulletin #9 which establishes a new plan for use of statewide data indicators and national standards as contextual data for the third round of the Federal Child and Family Services Review (CFSR). While ACF is revising the national standards, California continues to utilize the current national standards and will continue to do so until ACF establishes and releases information regarding the new national standards.

It is anticipated that the revised C-CFSR Manual will be released within the next year. Revisions will include updates to procedural aspects of the C-CFSR process and enhanced content on county-tribal engagement within C-CFSR. Discussions are also underway for incorporating content into the Manual about the Integrated Core Practice Model (ICPM). Prior to being released, the C-CFSR Manual will undergo stakeholder review.

The CDSS looks forward to working with you on our mutual efforts to achieve better outcomes for the children and families served by California's Child Welfare Services and Probation Placement programs.
