Probation Impact

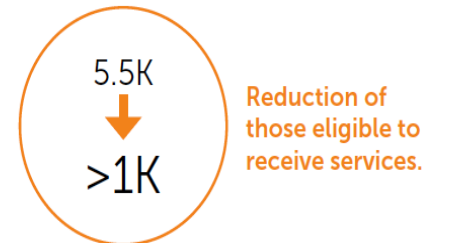

WITHOUT THE WAIVER, ONLY 15-20% OF CURRENT YOUTH BEING SERVED WOULD BE ELIGIBLE.



Only those youth at imminent risk would be eligible to receive these services.
