- Mix of professional and community support


1997 – CA Senate Bill 163



Probation as part of the Wrap TEAM

- Expectations on their role
- Communicate Clearly
- Arrest is a tool, but not the only tool
 - Legal exceptions to arrest
 - Not in client's best interest
 - Not consistent with other case management

Common Misconceptions

Probation Does Nothing Probation Should
Do Everything

Probation MUST ARREST



"Joey"- potential school shooter

17, male, previous WIC 300
First arrest, moderate behavioral issues.

Criminality

Low level, however idolized school shooters, had manifesto written, just missed the bus. Misdemeanor therefore low custody time available.

Involved in Counseling Prior to Wrap

Family issues, getting what he wants in counseling.

Challenges with first Wrap team

Intelligent and Articulate

Joey in Wrap

Collaboration

- Hightened sense of getting it right
- Safety plan with locals, school district police etc
- Enhanced involvement from PO
- Changed wrap team

Joey in Wrap Continued

Results

- Progress with second Wrap team
- Mother split with stepfather
- "It's ok mom, you can tell them"
- Graduated Wraparound
- Dismissed from probation, no further issues.
