# Understanding Wraparound Services

- **Wraparound is a comprehensive, strengths-based, planning process**
- **Builds on individual and family strengths to help families achieve positive goals and improve well-being.**
- **It is a team-driven process. A child and family team is formed and works directly with the family as they identify their own needs and strengths.**
- **The team develops a service plan that describes specific strategies for meeting the needs identified by the family.**
- **The service plan is individualized, with strategies that reflect the child and family's culture and preferences.**



# Understanding Wraparound Services: High Fidelity Wraparound

High-Fidelity Wraparound refers to adherence to all ten core principles and four phases of Wraparound and is defined as full alignment with the California Wraparound Standards, as outlined in ACIN I-52-15.

- 8. Collaboration**
- 9. Outcomes-Based**
- 10. Persistence**

# Wraparound Services and the Juvenile Justice Continuum

- **Prevention and Early Intervention Strategies**
- **Intensive Services for Justice-Involved Youth**
- **Aftercare when transitioning from an STRTP**
  - \* FFPSA Part IV Requirements October 1, 2021





# OC Wraparound

- **Child Welfare, Behavioral Health, and Probation**
- **Serving OC Families since 2021**
- **High Fidelity**
- **MOU- 1 designated Probation Supervisor**
- **Ages 12-18/ 602 WIC Wards**
- **50 designated slots for probation youth**
- **Cost to Probation for WIC 602 ward participation, unless there is a placement order and being utilized as aftercare**



# Key Programs in Orange County supporting justice-involved youth

## Youthful Offender Wraparound

- **Orange County Behavioral Services Full-Service Partnership.**
- **Culturally competent in-home and community-based services for Serious Emotional Disturbance (SED) youthful offenders .**
- **Ages 12-25 with juvenile probation history. Unlimited capacity**
- **Crisis services for all enrolled clients 24-hours a days/ 7-days a week, as needed.**
- **No cost to Probation.**



# Key Programs in Orange County supporting justice-involved youth

## Active Recidivism Reduction Initiative via Engagement (ARRIVE)

- OC Probation contracts with a vendor to deliver the ARRIVE program
- WIC 602 wards, ages 12-25. Capacity 50 youth.
- Participants include youth and parents/primary caregiver(s).
- Participants typically will not require the comprehensive services provided by a Full-Service Partnership like Wraparound OC.
- Services will be provided until youth and family meets case plan goals or has received 6 months of services, whichever is lesser.
- JJCPA Funded



# Implementation with DPOs

- **Takes time for DPOs to learn how to strategically navigate referral process based on which program offers the services needed, limited capacity, and lengthy referral process**
- **Takes time for DPOs to learn how to engage youth and families to buy-in to wraparound services.**



# OC Wraparound

## WFI Quarterly Fidelity Analysis

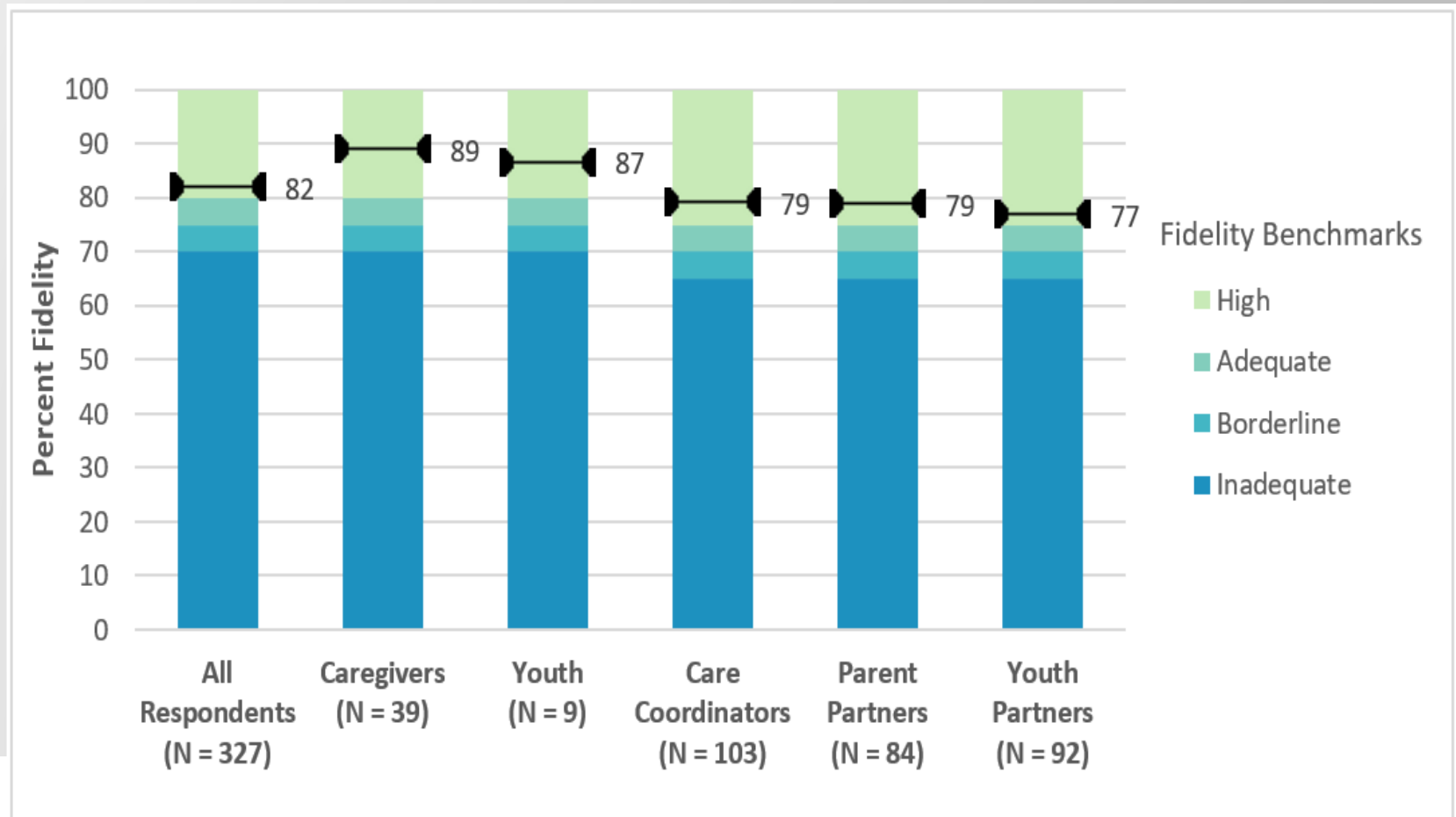
October – December 2024

- **327 WFI-EZ survey responses were collected from Wraparound team members for this report**
- **Included 39 Caregivers, 9 Youth, 103 Care Coordinators (also known as Wraparound Facilitators), 84 Parent Partners, and 92 Youth Partners (also known as Team Members). The 327 survey responses are associated with 134 families referred to OC Wraparound services.**



# OC Wraparound

**Overall Fidelity.** Across all respondents, Wraparound fidelity was assessed to be High (82 out of 100). Fidelity was High for all respondent types.
