# EXIT UPON ENTRY

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- **Michigan Youth Reentry Model**

- Exit Upon Entry- reentry starts on day **One**.
  - **Reentry planning begins the first day in the facility and continues through transition, reintegration and supervision in the community.**

Phase I:  
Getting Ready

Assessment and Case Plan  
Behavior & Programming

Phase 2:  
Going Home

Transition Preparation  
Release Decision Making

Phase III:  
Staying Home

Supervision  
Continuity of Services

# PARTNERSHIP-YOUTH FOR CHANGE

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- **Overcoming the limitations of traditional Wraparound**
- **Key concepts:**
  - Flexibility of services- in/out of custody
  - Continuity of care- relationship building
  - Includes the entire family system
  - High Fidelity Wraparound
  - Trauma- Informed focus

# REENTRY WRAPAROUND

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- 90 days prior to release
- Child Family Team (CFT) Meetings
- Family Engagement
- Individualized- operating on one plan
- Continuity of Services
- Outings/Temporary Releases (TR's)

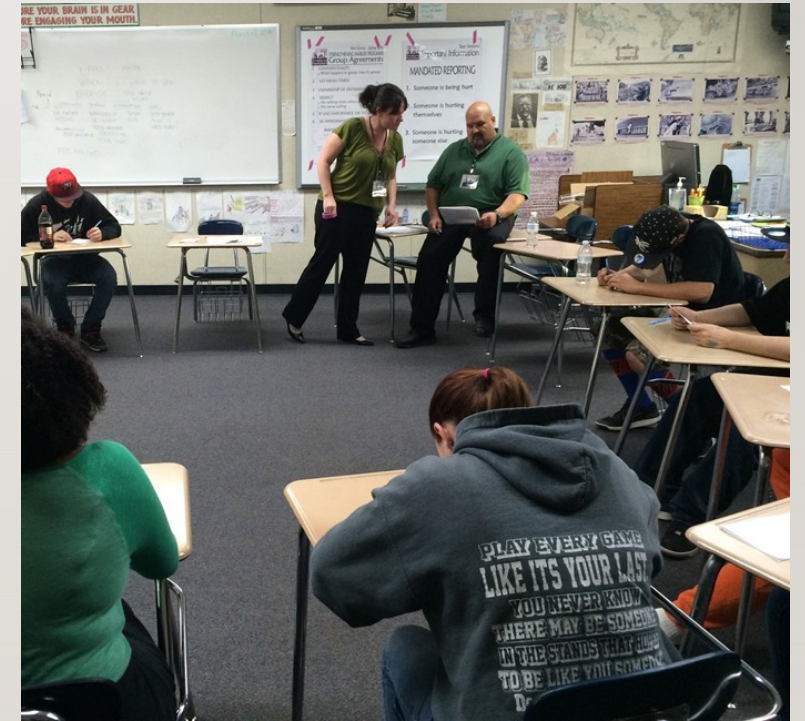
# WHAT IS WORKING?
