


KEY COMPONENTS OF TRANSITION TO EFC

- Collaborate on Projects

TRANSITION TO EFC

BACKGROUND OF TRANSITION TO EFC PROCESS

- The Transition from STRTP to EFC was Lacking:
 - Standardization/Structure
 - Education for NMD about EFC
 - Input from the NMD
 - Warm-handoff
- Process created instability (frequent movement)



26% stayed in their first THP or SILP


BASELINE DATA

- 55% moved 1-4 times (average 2.3 moves)
- 19% moved 5+ times (average 6.1 moves)

PURPOSE OF TRANSITION TO EFC PROCESS

- Create a standardized and structured workflow
 - Step-by-step roles and responsibilities
 - Warm handoff
 - Increase NMD's knowledge of EFC
 - Included NMD's input
- Achieve stability AT ENTRY into EFC
 - Reduce Trauma
 - Foster successful outcomes

THP QUESTIONNAIRE



- Familiarity with THP Programs
 - Created THP Questionnaire
 - Key Information
 - Shared with NMD
 - Informs NMD's choice

TRANSITIONAL INTERVIEW


- Prior to exiting STRTP
 - Introduction to EFC
 - Eligibility Criteria
 - Types of Housing
 - Rules and Expectations
 - Identify NMD's interests, goals, and plan to meet eligibility
 - Identify NMD's geographic preference
 - Identify a best-fit THP and refer NMD

OUTCOMES — EARLY STAGES OF IMPLEMENTATION FOCUS HAS SHIFTED

- Inconsistent
- Reactive
- Top Down
- Uninformed of NMD's voice and choice
- Moving Frequently
- Quantity

- Standardized
- Proactive
- Bottom Up
- Informed of NMD's voice and choice
- Preserving Stability
- Quality

OUTCOMES – LATER STAGES OF IMPLEMENTATION



DATA TRACKING

Evaluate Effectiveness

Identify Improvement Opportunities

Data Points:

- Date entered EFC
- Number of moves since first EFC placement (if any)
- Date and reason for move (Positive vs. Negative)
- Incidence of stable outcomes upon aging out of EFC

REPLICATION

- You can implement this in your county
- Partner with Social Services to host collaborative meetings with local THPs
- Streamline your process
- Engage NMDs in a Transitional Interview
- Establish stable housing AT ENTRY into EFC
- Reduce the trauma related to frequently moving
- Handouts available
